Gregg helps Owego to fast start

* Year in school: Senior.

* Sport: Boys soccer.

* Notable achievement: Gregg, a center midfielder, had three goals and an assist in Owego's 4-2 victory over previously unbeaten Susquehanna Valley on Friday. For the season, Gregg has seven goals and seven assists in helping the Indians to a 6-1 record and a share of the Southern Tier Athletic Conference Central Division lead with Maine-Endwell and Johnson City.

* Athlete's perspective: "It was very important," Gregg said of his performance against SV. "We need that kind of scoring to be competitive in the division that we're in."

On his improved play from last season: "I'm not surprised, we have a good team, so it makes it easier. I played (center midfield) last year, so I'm used to the position. I feel I have improved the most on controlling the midfield, setting the plays up from the sideline, getting players up and down the field, talking a lot more. I think that comes from having more confidence in myself."

* Coach's perspective: "Coming into the season, I saw him as being a leader and he's stepped into that role." Owego coach Jason Luke said. "Obviously, he plays a vital role in the midfield for us. . He does a nice job offensively and defensively."

On Gregg's performance against SV: "That was pretty much what I thought we would get from Nick this season. When Nick is playing well, our team is playing well."

* Opponent's perspective: "He's a tall kid, and he's pretty physical," Windsor coach Jeff Nolan said. "It seems like everything in the midfield goes through him. He gets a lot of 50-50 balls and starts their forward pressure."

* Other sports: Lacrosse.

* Immediate goal: To at least reach the Section 4 Class A title match.

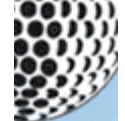
* Long-term goal: To play soccer at the collegiate level.
