Dear Parents:

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you and your child to first grade. It is always exciting to meet new friends in September.

One way to help organize those first days for all of us is for your child to come prepared with supplies. We are sending this list now so that you can take advantage of the "Summer Specials" offered in so many of the stores.

Your child will need the following items labeled with his/her name.

1. A back pack, book bag or plastic bag to carry daily.
2. A pocket folder for carrying papers, notes, etc. from school to home.

The following items should not be **labeled**, as they will become community supplies for the classroom:

1. A box of Ziploc bags (1 quart and 1 gallon) - these bags are used for a variety of purposes such as - carrying reading books, sending projects home, and bagging children's supplies.
2. Two clear trash bags, with handles, large enough to hold your child's outside clothing, book bag, etc. We have found that this helps reduce the spread of lice.
3. Three pocket folders (plastic coated).
4. A pair of child's scissors.
5. \*Two boxes of Kleenex.
6. \*A box of 24 crayons.
7. \*At least 6 large glue sticks.
8. \*A pack of pencils.
9. Markers.

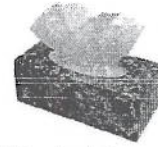
\* These items may have to be replenished periodically based on usage.

- 1 handheld pencil sharpener

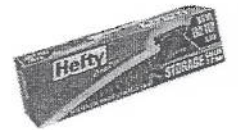


- 1 box of Kleenex tissues

- 1 package of Post-It Notes (any size)

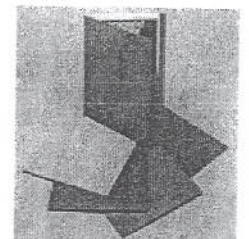
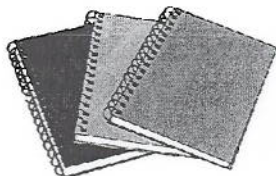
- 2 packages - 3 x 5 ruled index cards
